Manual Part 2 Safety Advice

Thank you!

Thank you for choosing a Dancover awning. We hope that you will enjoy the product. For you to get the most out of the product, we recommend that you read this Safety Advice carefully before you install and use the awning. Pay attention to the safety advice especially! We also recommend that you keep this manual somewhere safe so that you can use it when necessary.

Attention!

Before you start to install the awning, please be sure to check that everything you need is there according to the list of parts in this manual. Be sure that you have received everything and that nothing is missing or damaged. In case of missing or damaged parts, please fill out a Claim to Dancover before you start installing the awning!

Get a professional to install the awning

For your safety and for the safety of others it is important that you apply with the following safety advice.

In order to install the awning correctly, you must have a certain degree of technical knowledge. If not, please contact a professional. If you are in any way in doubt about the following, please have a professional do the installation:

- 1. If you are unsure whether the awning can be fastened to where you want it.
- 2. You do not understand the manual or part of it
- 3. You do not have the tools required to do the job
- 4. You do not have the technical knowledge or experience to do the job

Minimum two persons for the job!

You must be at least two adults to install the awning as it is heavy and large. Never try to install the awning alone! If the awning falls down it can easily cause serious damage to persons and building and may be broken. Again, contact a professional to do the job.

Keep children and pets away from the area while the awning is being installed and adjusted. The awning and the fittings are made to be installed on a flat concrete wall or a stable brick wall – preferably not a plastered wall. If you detect cracks in the wall, contact a professional. If your house has any kind of extra layer like cladding, insulation or similar, you should have a professional to estimate whether it is possible to mount the awning onto the wall. Sometimes it is only a question of using another kind of fittings or screws, but again – let a professional make the decision. If you use the wrong kind of fittings and more, the warranty will lapse!

Do not change the design of the product or functionality as you may break the awning. Also, the warranty will lapse if you do so.

NEVER cut the cord!

Always mount the awning on fittings placed according to manual. Never cut the cord on the awning as the warranty will lapse and you can bring danger to yourself and others. Instead, prolong the existing cord and plug by using an extension cord or similar.

Snow and rain

Please note that operating the awning in very cold weather may cause the product to break. Operating the awning in snowy weather will also cause damage. When it rains, we recommend that you draw in the awning if the drop or pitch is less than 14°. Also draw back the awning in windy weather.

Never climb onto the awning and never attach or hang anything from the awning.

Attention!

You must be two adults minimum and preferably with a little technical insight to install this awning. Make sure that the wall is suitable for mounting the awning. If in doubt, contact a professional as the warranty will lapse if you have mounted the awning on a non-bearing wall. Double-check where to drill before fastening the fittings for the awning. It is essential that you consider where to place the awning before you start to install. If you are going to fasten the awning onto a brick wall, make sure that you drill holes in the bricks and not in the gaps or joints as they may not be strong enough to hold the awning!

Insurance

Make sure to check whether your awning is covered by your house contents insurance or similar.

Warranty information

Dancover warranty applies only to the normal use of the product, normal wear and tear excepted, in accordance with written use instructions or manual. The warranty does not apply to damage caused by accident, abuse, misuse, or modification of the product. If you need to clean the awning at some point, only use a mild detergent and lukewarm or cold water. Do not use strong agents of any kind.
